Phase 2 includes a minimum of 5 hours per week Directed Learning in DynaSpeak Online™ (with additional Self-Directed learning material available up to 15 hours).

** Please note: Internet may not be available in all homestays. Additional charges for internet access may apply. Free wifi is available at DynaSpeak.

*** Students who book homestay accommodation through DynaSpeak must also utilise DynaSpeak arranged transportation service to the homestay.

**** For Under 18 students DynaSpeak arranged return transportation service is compulsory.

How to Enrol

Contact your agent for complete details of enrolment and visa requirements. If you have no local agent you may contact DynaSpeak directly or enrol online at www.dynaspeak.ac.nz. Email, fax or post your completed Application Form to the school. DynaSpeak will confirm your place and course dates, and send an invoice for fees and payment instructions. Pay your fees to your agent or to DynaSpeak directly. Remember to check if you require a visa and, if so, arrange your visa well before you intend to start studying.

Do I Need a Visa?
